

Minutes of the Maldon Sharks AGM 29th November 2010

It was agreed to arrange a Xmas party involving a meal at Izumis and bowling at Madison Heights, date and time tba, but likely to be sometime between Xmas and the New Year.

This would depend on availability and if there was enough interest amongst the swimmers and parents.
